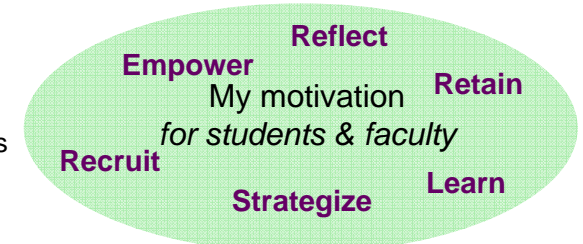

## What I Needed to Learn

You might have a good question in there, BUT  
• How do you explain it so that others see your vision?  
• How do you expand your idea of approaches?  
• How do you narrow down your problem?  
• How do you separate multiple factors to get useful data?

*Where should I start?*

*Ask different questions!*



**Feedback:** "I am glad to see that you have narrowed your thinking down to one post it."

What is top priority, i.e., what knowledge will help me address the other questions?

Do potential reviewers understand my terms?

What form will my outcomes take?

What is available in my context?

What is feasible?

What are the right tools?

What is measurable?

What population am I focusing on?

What theory will support & address my question?

Hmmm, will this improve learning?
